Reminders:

- Please continue to respect the quality of our water by ensuring that nothing is littered.
 - Litter is meant to be disposed of correctly in your homes and then disposed of at Waste Disposal Sites.
 - Please do not throw garbage or any recycling on our roadways or to the side of the road.
 - We have a number of thoughtful families around that continue to clean up the roads and we would like to thank them for making an effort to keep our community clean.
- The Paint Lake community is friendly and one where you are encouraged to speak to your neighbors about concerns ahead of engaging the executives on matters that could be resolved between yourselves.
 - In addition, we hope resolution is the goal and no need to involve authority figures such as bylaw and police.
- Please drive slowly on the road.
 - We have noticed the speed of vehicles on Paint Lake Road have increased since the clearing of the trees. Our roads are used for both vehicular traffic and pedestrian activity.
 - Please respect the posted speed limits and consider the safety of your neighbours!
 - Reminder: The speed limit for vehicles is 40km/hr or below. The speed limit for off road vehicles is half the posted speed limit.
- The Paint Lake bridge between Bellwood Acres Road and Paint Lake Road is for both pedestrians and off-road vehicles. Please ensure all off-road vehicles give right of way to pedestrian traffic and travel no more than 10km/hr on the bridge.
